PGF reports will contain the following elements:

- 1. PGF logo, the A2LA accredited laboratory logo, and the PGF mailing address;
- 2. Report title;
- 3. Report date;
- 4. PGF case number;
- 5. Investigating agency case number;
- 6. Investigating agency contact and address;
- 7. Suspects and/or Victims (if available);
- 8. Items received into the laboratory for testing;
- 9. Analysis performed including a brief description of the methodologies employed
- 10. Results and conclusions;
- 11. Additional remarks and evidence disposition including indicating if any items received were not tested;
- 12. Additional remarks and evidence disposition including indicating if any items received were consumed during analysis;
- 13. Signature and title of the analyst accepting responsibility for the report content and the signature and title of the technical reviewer.
